

Directions to Tweedhill Fishings

Post code: TD15 1XQ

(Shiel fishing hut car park What3Words: laptop.highlight.financial)

There is easy access to the A1(T) at Berwick-upon-Tweed, which also has a railway station on the East Coast Mainline, with direct access to Edinburgh and Newcastle (45 minutes each) and London (3¾ hours).

There are international airports at both Edinburgh and Newcastle-upon-Tyne.

Tweedhill is situated approximately six miles west of Berwick-upon-Tweed and the A1 (around 15 minutes drive in total).

From the Berwick A1 bypass, take the B6461 (signposted to Kelso and Paxton) along the north side of the river. After four miles, turn left at the sign to Fishwick and Fishwick Mains. There is also a Tweedhill Fishings sign. (What3Words: nightfall.sensible.complies)

After passing Fishwick Mains farmhouse, the tarmac ends and it becomes a concrete farm track. This is well maintained and is perfectly decent to drive along:

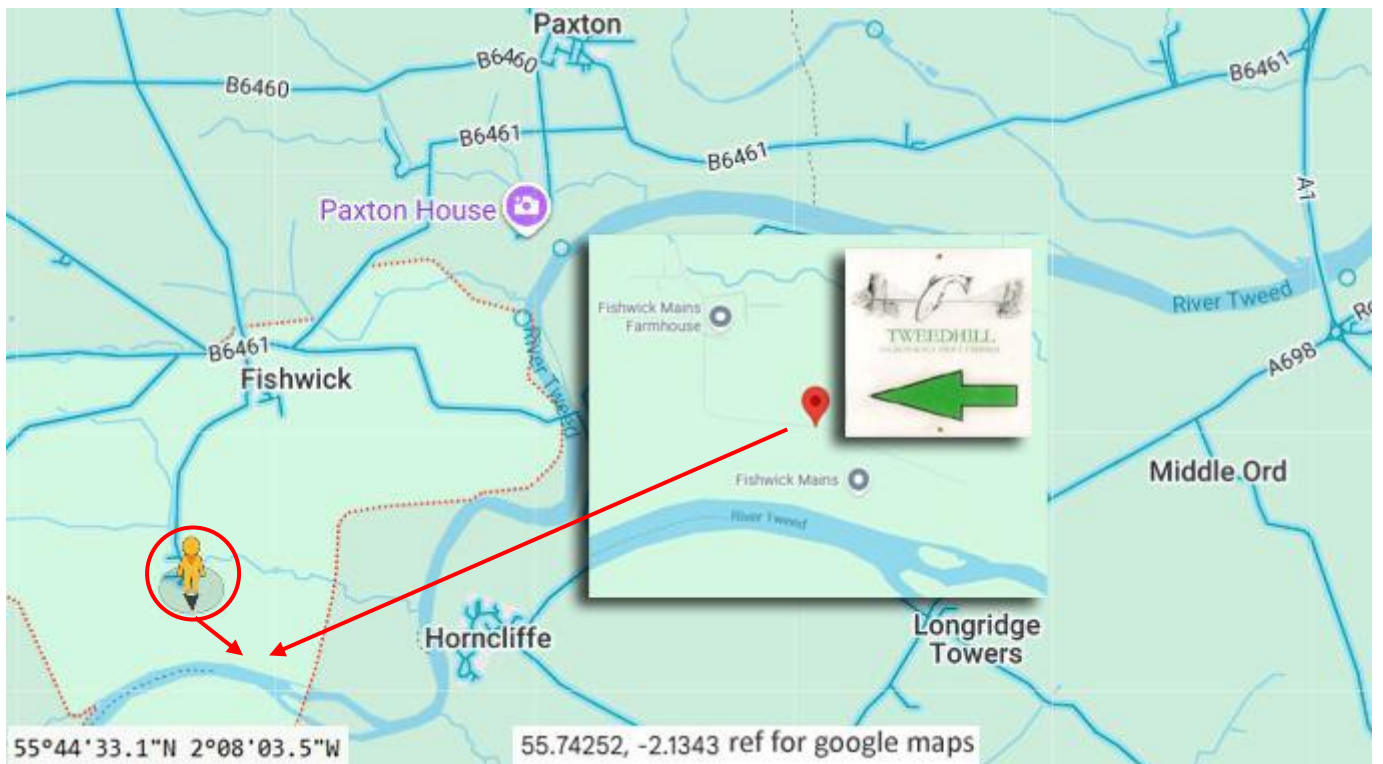


After a short distance this becomes a conventional farm track, which is also well maintained.

After half a mile, you'll see the river below you, where the track bends to the right. Go downhill, and you'll pass our upper car park, as the track turns left along the river for a further half a mile.

When you get to the Shiel, our main fishing hut, park on the mown grass.



There is also a lay-by you can park in, by the Union Bridge. (branched.action.curvy)
